## Language: There is / there are

When we write about a place we use sentences such as:

| THERE | VERB | WHAT? | WHERE? |
| :---: | :---: | :--- | :--- |
| There | is | a double bed | in my bedroom. |
| $\ldots$. There | are | many camels | on the farm. |

Note: 'is / are' come from the verb 'to be'.
'is' is used for singular nouns (e.g. There $\underline{i s}$ a camel market [1] )
'are' is used for plural nouns (e.g. There are many malls. [more than 1 mall] )
