

THERE There There	VERB is are	WHAT? a double bed many camels	WHERE? in my bedroom. on the farm.				
<ul> <li><u>Note</u>: 'is / are' come from the verb 'to be'.</li> <li>'is' is used for singular nouns (e.g. There <u>is</u> a camel market [1])</li> <li>'are' is used for plural nouns (e.g. There <u>are</u> many malls. [more than 1 mall])</li> </ul>
